Bardessono Environmental Initiatives

- 14,000 sq. ft of 200 kilowatt solar photo voltaic systems on rooftops
- Eighty two 300 foot wells are bored beneath the Bardessono as part of a geothermal system which provides heating and cooling of rooms and preheating of domestic hot water
- Automated external venetian blinds on windows to block heat and cold and reduce heating and conditioning
- Occupancy sensors that turn off lights and alter thermostats to reduce energy while guest is out of room
- LED and fluorescent light fixtures to reduce electrical demand
- Low water use fixtures, dual flush toilets, drip irrigation, drought resistant plants to reduce water usage
- The Town of Yountville recycles grey and black waters and sells it for irrigation use.
- Recycled wood from: Monterey Cypress, orchard Walnut, California Laurel Bay and Eucalyptus milled for doors, siding, flooring and furniture
- Redwood ceilings from old wine tanks
- Glues, adhesives, paints, and wall coverings with low VOC (volatile organic compounds)
- Concrete with a high potash (recycled product) content
- Glass Tiles with a high recycled content
- Steel with a high recycled content
- Organic linens and terry
- Organic cleaning products
- Furnishings with environmentally friendly fabrics
- Spa ingredients with botanical organic ingredients
- Restaurant food organic and local whenever possible
